# 1.2.1. Settings->Controls




Image 2 Controls menu item appears in the Setting menu.




Image 3 Controls window appears when user clicked control menu item.

This menu item allows user to disable preview of Easy Onair clients.



This menu item allows user to add the information of Mail account and any SMTP (outgoing) server.



Email Settings menu item appears in the Setting menu.





### 1.2.7. Settings->Network Transfer

When system configuration has network-attached storage (NAS) to be used location of media, the playlist items can be transferred to local system. Network Transfer menu item appears in the Setting menu.



This menu item allows user to set IP address of Subtitle devices in case of the system support subtitle devices.



- Maximum item count in the playlist in a packet which will send Easy Onair. This option is to be valid when the system supports Easy Playlist Editor.





**New NCS** is used to add new Easy Net Control client. Press **New NCS** button and NCS window will appear. Fill IP address and port of client the press Ok button.





User can control Easy Onair client's playlists via Easy Net Control. These controls are Play, Pause, Stop, Jump, Next and Play Next.



Cued video files on playlist are played by pressing Play button on the control menu, or clicking Play this on right-click menu of video file.

Video files on playlist are removed by clicking Remove on right-click menu of video file in content field.

# 2.2. Usage of Control Menu

Play : Plays a chosen or cued video file.

Pause: Pauses onair video file.

Stop: Stops onair video file.

Next: Jumps to next file.

Jump : Jumps to chosen file.

Cue : Cues chosen file.

## 2.3. Time Monitoring

The main clock represents remaining time of video file as shown with red font as shown on Image 21.



Elapsed counter represents elapsed time of video file as shown on the upper left side on Image 21.

Total counter represents total duration of video file as shown on the lower left side on Image 21.

**Clip** label represent the name of video file playing on Easy Onair at the moment as shown on the right side on Image 21.

**Playlist** label represent the name of playlist playing on Easy Onair at the moment as shown on the right side on Image 21.
